

General Information

The following is some important information regarding Battle of the Books. Please contact the Yorba Linda Public Library at 714-777-2873 ext. 6 or ext. 7, with any questions or concerns.

1. Teams should check-in at the Lakeview Elementary School Multipurpose Room **15 minutes before** their scheduled start time. Lakeview Elementary School is located at 17571 Lakeview, Yorba Linda, 92886.
2. All teams participating in a “Battle” will need to be waiting outside their assigned room **5 minutes before** the scheduled start time.
3. Any teams that are late for their scheduled “Battle” time will automatically forfeit their “Battle.” The Reader will wait for a maximum of **3 minutes** for all team members to arrive.
4. Students participating in the Battle will need to check-in at the Lakeview Elementary School Multipurpose Room as a team **15 minutes** before their scheduled start time. Teams should arrange to meet outside **15 minutes** before their check-in time to ensure that all members are present. For example: If the scheduled start time of your teams “Battle” is 10:00, meet your team at 9:30 and then check-in in the Multipurpose Room at 9:45.
5. Participants may bring notes/flash cards to review while they are waiting for their scheduled start time, however, no notes/flash cards may be used during the “Battle.”
6. Light refreshments will be provided at the Battle, however, participants are encouraged to bring their own snacks. This is a multi-hour event and teams that advance to the final rounds in the competition will be “Battling” about 12:00 p.m. Please note: There will be no food or drink allowed in the classrooms. Snacks and refreshments may be eaten outside at the lunch tables.
7. Teams are **strongly** encouraged to carpool to the Battle due to limited parking.
8. Teams are required to select a Team Captain before the event. The Team Captain is the person who will be providing the team’s answer to the Reader.
9. Please have the attached Photo Release Form filled out and turned in to the Yorba Linda Public Library by Saturday, February 20th. Some photos **may** be used for public relations purposes.
