## An Evening with John Gilmore

**B**efore he found his true calling as a writer, John Gilmore was an actor during Hollywood's Golden Age. He was friends with James Dean and Marilyn Monroe and hung out with some of the most interesting people of the era, like Jack Kerouac, William S. Burroughs, Jane Fonda and Peter Lorre.

In his writing, John Gilmore explores the dark side of human nature, investigating famous murders such as the Black Dahlia (whom he had actually met as a boy) and Charles Manson. His books are deep and gritty explorations of the truth behind the glamour. Who killed the Black Dahlia? Why did the Family follow Manson? How did Charles Schmid, the "Pied Piper of Tucson," attract young victims? These are the questions he investigates.
